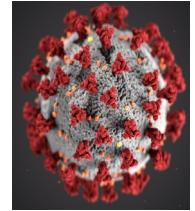


Lockdown diaries

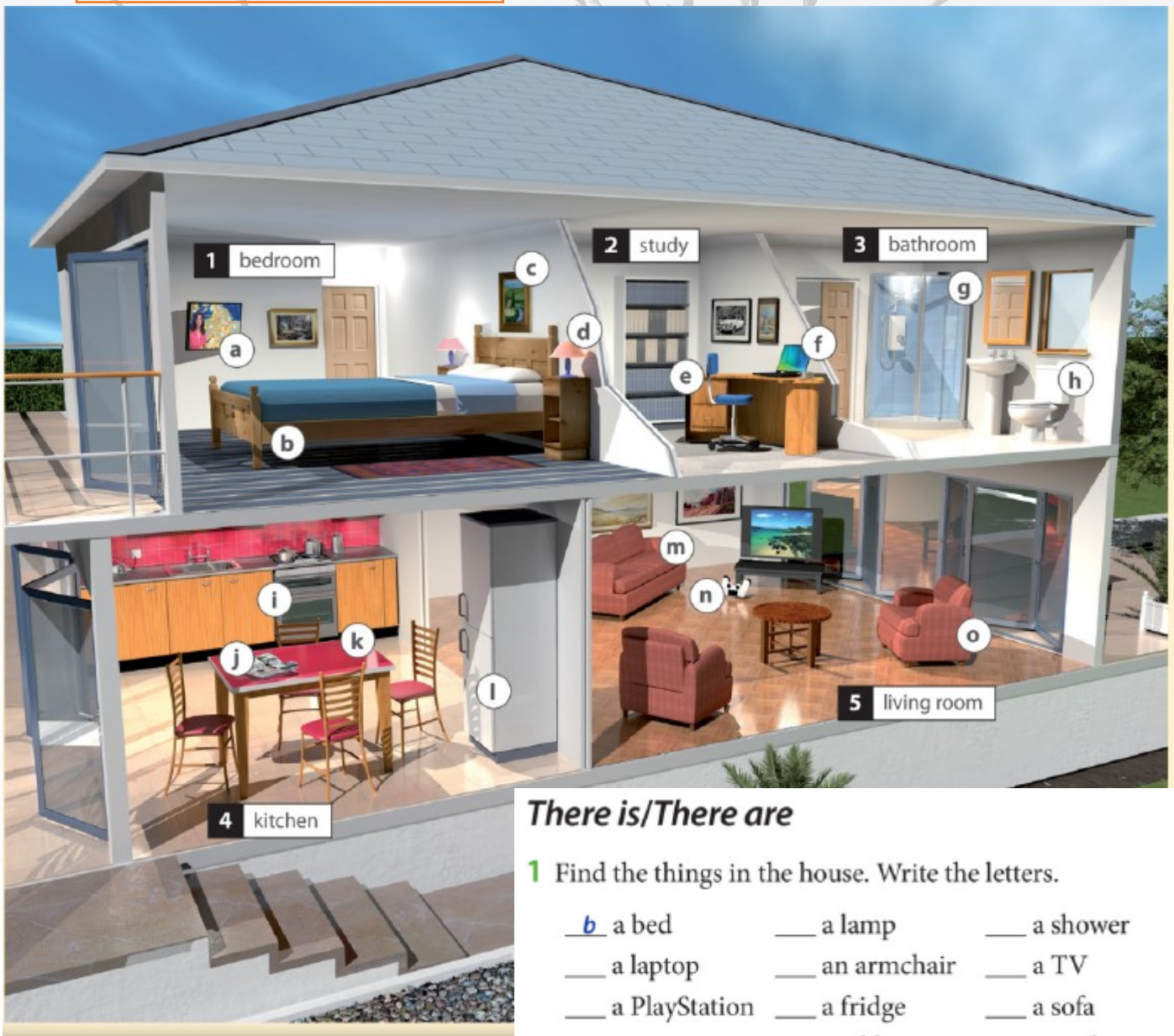
Il y a une pomme sur la table veut dire en fait **il existe** une pomme sur la table.

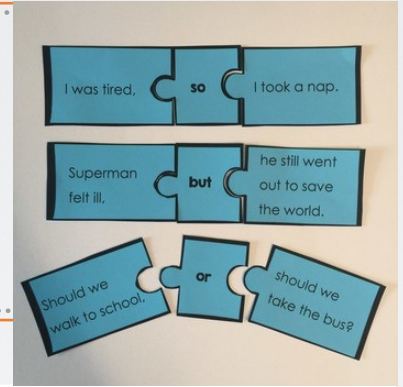

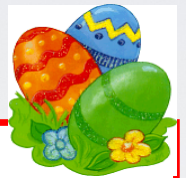
